

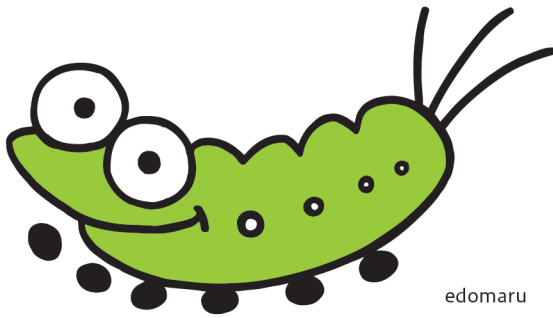

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Punch a hole



【Perforating guide】

Make a mini Edomaru kite

What you need

- ◆ Kite string (60 cm)
 - ◆ Bamboo strips (for tying the kite string to)
 - ◆ Sticky tape/glue
 - ◆ Scissors/penknife
 - ◆ Hole punch or other perforating tool (for punching holes in the paper)
 - ◆ Sheets 1 and 2 printed out on A4 paper
- Sheet 1:** Print **【Kite】** (3 designs) and **【Perforating guide】** on thick paper (about the thickness of a postcard).
- Sheet 2:** Print **【Tail】** on regular paper.

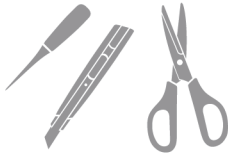

Ask a grown-up to help you with the tricky bits!



Steps:

- ① Cut along the cutting lines (—) of Sheet 1 **【Kite】** (3 designs) and **【Perforating guide】**, and Sheet 2 **【Tail】**.
- ② Place the **【Perforating guide】** over a **【Kite】** card and use a hole punch or other perforating tool to punch a hole through the card. ← Ask a grown-up to help you!
- ③ From the side of the **【Kite】** card with the picture on it, thread the kite string through and tie a knot on the reverse side. Then, put sticky tape over the knotted string to hold it in place.
- ④ On the reverse side of the **【Kite】** card, attach one **【Tail】** to each side of the bottom of the card. (You can use sticky tape or glue.)
- ⑤ Take the other end of the kite string that you have threaded through the **【Kite】** card, wind it around the top of a bamboo strip, then tie a knot.
